





Which of the following resources do you use for receiving news about Turkish Foreign Policy?



To what extent do you trust the following resources for receiving news about Turkish Foreign Policy?







Which institution or institutions make foreign policy in Turkey?








Which of the following individuals or institutions are active in implementing foreign policy in Turkey?





Which country or countries represent the most serious threat to Turkey?















Do you think the EU is behaving credibly and sincerely towards Turkey?



When Turkey can be a full member of the EU?








Do you think Turkey's membership to the EU is blocked?




How will Turkey benefit from EU membership?








Do you think Turkey's membership would be beneficial to the EU?




How will the EU benefit from Turkey's membership?

Which of the following could be an alternative to the EU membership?




9.8% of participants state that EU membership has no alternative and the process should go on; while **13%** say that Turkey should not join any union.


What do you think about the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus in its relations with Turkey?

Under which condition(s) Turkey should recognize the Republic of Cyprus?







What is the most important problem between Turkey and Greece?






How will the ruling party in Greece (Syriza-led government) affect the relations between Turkey and Greece?










What are the most important areas of cooperation between Turkey and the USA?








Is there a problem between Turkey and the USA?








How do you characterize the USA in its relations with Turkey?



Do you think that Turkey's membership to NATO should continue?




It is observed that Turkey's membership to NATO is being supported increasingly since 2010.









Do you think that ISIS is a terrorist organization?









Which country has the most influence on shaping the future of the Middle East after the Arab Spring?




