Projects and initiatives in the area of Sustainable Development: Sustainable development is a significant area of research and study for the CIES. It recently launched a new initiative titled **“Talking Development: The Global Approach, Global Goals and Local Solutions”** comprised of a series of periodic debates on each of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals while it also includes the launching of a **SDG Multi-Stakeholder Platform** in partnership with business and Civil Society Organizations. The CIES is currently conducting a research project on **“Analysis of the Perceptions and the Implementation of Sustainable Development Goals in Turkey by the Business sector and Civil Society Organizations”**. The CIES together with CSR Turkey organized Turkey’s first Diplohack event on **Sustainable Development Goals** in Istanbul in 2018. In 2019, it hosted a **Kapuscinski Development Lecture** funded by the European Commission and UNDP. The CIES has also implemented trainings on **Sustainable Development Goals** for the youth and civil society organizations in partnership with the UNDP Istanbul Regional Hub. All aforementioned projects have been held in cooperation with a number of international and national institutional partners and co-sponsors. Apart from its in-house expertise, the CIES works with other Kadir Has University research centers, departments, and initiatives on the implementation of **SDGs 4, 5, 8, 11, 16, and 17**. It is also a member of the **Sustainable Development Solutions Network (SDSN)**.
