

# DOUBLE MAJOR PROGRAM

## HOW CAN I APPLY? WHAT ARE THE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS?

- ❖ The student must be at the beginning of the 3rd semester at the earliest and the 5th semester at the latest.
- ❖ Must be successful in all courses taken.
- ❖ GPA must be minimum 2.72.
- ❖ Students must be in the first 20% of the relevant class in terms of success ranking. If you are not in the 20% percentile, your score in the year you are placed must be equal to or higher than the base score of the department you want to do DMP.
- ❖ In order to do a double major in a program that requires a success ranking requirement (Law, Engineering, Architecture), you must meet the Higher Education Institutions Examination success ranking requirement of the relevant program in the year you enrolled in addition to the 20% slice.
- ❖ Students who transfer from abroad or who are admitted and enrolled from abroad cannot double major in programs where success ranking is required (Law, Engineering, Architecture).
- ❖ Students cannot enrol in more than one double major program at the same time. However, it is possible to enrol in a double major program and a minor program at the same time.

## WHAT ARE THE CONDITIONS TO CONTINUE? IN WHAT CIRCUMSTANCES DOES IT COME TO DISENROLLED?

- ❖ The student's GPA in the major program may drop to 2.50 for one time only during the double major program. Students whose GPA in the major program falls below 2.72 for the second time are dismissed from the double major program.
- ❖ Students who do not take courses from the double major program for two consecutive semesters are dismissed from this program. This provision does not apply to students who are abroad for two consecutive semesters due to Erasmus or exchange program.
- ❖ The scholarships of double major students continue uninterrupted for a maximum of four years (eight semesters) starting from the semester they start the double major program.

## WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION?

- ❖ In order to graduate from the double major program, the student must take all the courses specified in the curriculum and have a GPA of at least 2.72.
- ❖ In order to graduate from the double major program, the student must first graduate from the major program.
- ❖ For students who cannot complete their double major program, the maximum period of study is 7 (seven) years starting from the academic year in which they enrolled in the double major program.
