

MINOR PROGRAM

HOW CAN I APPLY? WHAT ARE THE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS?

- ❖ The student must be at the beginning of the 3rd semester at the earliest and the 6th semester at the latest.
- ❖ He/she must be successful in all the courses she/he has taken.
- ❖ GPA must be at least 2.50.
- ❖ A student whose registration has been canceled from the minor program cannot re-register to the same minor program.
- ❖ A minor cannot be done in more than one program at the same time. However, it is possible to enroll in a double major program and a minor program at the same time.

WHAT ARE THE CONDITIONS TO CONTINUE? IN WHAT CIRCUMSTANCES DOES IT COME TO DISENROLLED?

- ❖ In order for the student to continue in the minor program, the GPA in the major program must be at least 2.29. A student who cannot meet this requirement for two consecutive semesters will be deregistered from the minor program.
- ❖ A student who does not take courses from the minor program for two consecutive semesters will be deregistered from this program. This provision does not apply to students who have been abroad for two consecutive semesters due to their Erasmus or exchange program.
- ❖ A student whose grade point average in the minor program is below 2.00 for two consecutive semesters in which he took courses from the minor program is canceled from the minor program.
- ❖ Students who have the right to graduate from the major program but cannot complete the minor program are given an additional period of two semesters at the most, with the decision of the relevant board of directors.
- ❖ Scholarships for minor students are limited to the duration of their major scholarships.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION?

- ❖ A minor certificate (certificate of achievement) is given to the student who has the right to graduate from the major program and completes the minor program with a minimum average of 2.00. This document does not replace the diploma.
- ❖ A student who has completed a minor program cannot benefit from the rights and authorities given with a bachelor's degree in the minor field.
