

## **MINOR PROGRAM**

WHAT ARE THE
CONTINUATION
CONDITIONS? IN
WHICH CASES
SHOULD BE DELETED?



- ❖ The student must be at the begining of the third semester at the earliest and at the begining of the sixth semester at the latest.
- He/she must be successful in all the courses she takes.
- ❖ Must be successful in all courses. GPA must be minimum 2.50.
- A student whose registration has been canceled from the minor program cannot re-register for the same minor program.
- ❖ It is possible to enroll in a double major and two minor programs at the same time.

- ❖ In order for the student to continue in the minor program, the GPA in the major program must be at least 2.29. A student who cannot meet this requirement for two consecutive semesters will be deregistered from the minor program.
- A student who does not take courses from the minor program for two consecutive semesters will be deregistered from this program. This provision does not apply to students who are abroad for two consecutive semesters for an Erasmus or Exchange program.
- Students who are eligible to graduate from the major program but cannot complete the minor program are given a maximum of two semesters of additional time by the decision of the relevant board of directors.
- ❖ Scholarships for minor students are limited to the duration of their scholarships in the major.
- ❖ A minor certificate (certificate of achievement) is given to the student who is eligible to graduate from the major program and completes the minor program with an average of at least 2.00. This document does not replace a diploma.
- A student who completes the minor program cannot benefit from the rights and authorities granted with a bachelor's degree in the minor field.
