GENERAL INFORMATION

Students may apply to a double major diploma program at the earliest, during the third semester, and at the latest, at the beginning of the fifth semester of the major program, on the dates specified in the academic calendar. To apply for a double major program, students must have successfully completed all courses taken in the major program up to the semester they apply. Applicants to Kadir Has University's programs requiring special talent must take and pass the special talent exams administered by the aforementioned programs. Enrollment in more than one double major diploma program is not permitted simultaneously. However, enrollment in a double major diploma and a minor program is permitted simultaneously.

Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.72/4.00 in their major program at the time of application and be in the top 20% of their respective class in the major program. Students who have a minimum GPA of 2.72/4.00 in their major program but are not in the top 20% of their respective class in the major program may apply for a double major program provided they have a central placement score no lower than the base score for the relevant year of the double major program. Students wishing to pursue a double major in programs requiring a success ranking must (Law, Engineering, and Architecture), in addition to the other requirements stipulated in these Regulations, also meet the success ranking requirement determined by the Council of Higher Education for the relevant program in the year of registration. Theatre students enrolled based on special talent must have a placement score no lower than the base score for the relevant year of programs not requiring a success ranking.

A student's GPA may be reduced to 65 out of 100 (2.50/4.00) once throughout the entire double major program. Students whose GPA falls below 65 out of 100 (2.50/4.00) for a second time will be dismissed from the second major program. Students who fail to take courses from the double major program for two consecutive semesters will be dismissed from the second major program. Courses taken and passed by students who are dismissed or withdrawn from the double major program may be substituted for elective courses in the major program upon the recommendation of their advisor and the decision of the relevant faculty board of directors. If these students have not yet met the graduation requirements for the major program, they may register for the minor program upon the decision of the relevant board of directors, provided they meet the application requirements for the minor programs.
