

DOUBLE MAJOR PROGRAM

HOW CAN I APPLY? WHAT ARE THE APPLICATION CONDITIONS?

- ❖ The student must be at the beginning of his 3rd semester at the earliest and at the beginning of his 5th semester at the latest.
- ❖ He/She must be successful in all the courses he takes.
- ❖ GPA must be minimum 2.72.
- ❖ Must be in the top 20% of the relevant class in terms of success ranking. If you are not in the 20% bracket, your score in the year you are placed must be equal to or higher than the base score of the department in which you want to major.
- ❖ In order to do a double major in a program that requires a success ranking (Law, Engineering, Architecture), in addition to the 20% percentile, you must also meet the YKS success ranking requirement of the relevant program in the year you enroll.
- ❖ Students who come from abroad through horizontal transfer or are accepted and registered from abroad cannot do a double major in programs that require success ranking (Law, Engineering, Architecture).
- ❖ It is not possible to enroll in more than one double major program at the same time. However, it is possible to enroll in a double major program and a minor program at the same time.

WHAT ARE THE CONTINUATION CONDITIONS? IN WHICH CASES SHOULD BE DELETED?

- ❖ The student's overall grade point average in the major program may decrease to 2.50 only once during the double major education.
- ❖ A student whose major program GPA falls below 2.72 for the second time will be deregistered from the double major program.
- ❖ A student who does not take courses in a double major program for two consecutive semesters will be deregistered from this program. This provision does not apply to students who are abroad for two consecutive semesters for an Erasmus or exchange program.
- ❖ Scholarships for double major students continue uninterrupted for a maximum of five years (ten semesters) starting from the semester in which they start the double major program.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION?

- ❖ In order to graduate from a double major program, the student must first graduate from the main major program.
- ❖ In order for the student to graduate from the double major program, he/she must take all the courses specified in the curriculum and he/she must graduate with GPA of at least 2.72 from the main major.
- ❖ The education period of students who cannot complete the double major program is a maximum of 7 (seven) years from the academic year in which they registered for Double Major.
