Single-Screen Grading and Feedback

When assignments are submitted as online text, the student's submission, grading panel, and feedback area are displayed on a single screen.

This allows instructors to grade and provide feedback without downloading files or switching between windows.

1 Turnitin Status – Similarity Information

Turnitin status and similarity information are displayed in this area.

2 Submission – Student Submission

The student's submission is displayed directly in this area; no file download is required.

3 Grade – Grading

Enter the grade in this section; it is automatically reflected in the gradebook.

4 Feedback Comments – Written Feedback

Written feedback to the student can be provided in this section.

5 Feedback Files – Additional Files

Additional files or a model answer can be uploaded in this section if needed.

Assignment Settings – Submission & Feedback Configuration

To enable grading through online text submission, it is recommended to review the following settings in the assignment configuration. With these settings, written assignments can be graded and feedback can be provided on a single screen.

Online Text; Enable Online Text for written assignments. This allows students to submit their text directly in the system.

Word Limit; (Optional) You may define a word limit if needed (e.g., 600 words).

Feedback Comments; Enable Feedback Comments to provide written feedback directly on the platform.

Feedback Files; Enable Feedback Files if you wish to upload a model answer or additional document.

Turnitin Configuration

If Turnitin is preferred, the Turnitin plugin must be enabled in the assignment settings and the following core options should be reviewed.

Turnitin usage is optional; for short written assignments, online text submission may be sufficient.

1 Enable Turnitin – Turnitin Activation

Activates Turnitin similarity checking.

2 Display Similarity Reports – Similarity Report Visibility

Determines whether students can view the similarity report.

3 Check Against – Comparison Sources

Specifies whether the submission is checked against internet sources, publications, and student papers.

4 Report Generation Speed – Report Generation Timing

Determines when the similarity report is generated.

5 Store Student Papers – Repository Storage

Determines whether submissions are stored in the Turnitin repository.

Grading & Feedback Process

Once the student submission is displayed, grading and feedback can be completed on the same page.

The score is entered in the Grade field and is automatically reflected in the gradebook.

Written feedback is provided through the Feedback comments section.

To view the Turnitin similarity report, click on the percentage (%) icon next to the submission; the report will open in a separate tab.

This structure allows grading, feedback, and similarity review to be managed efficiently from a single screen.
